

Asterisk Dialing Multiple Numbers

One of the nice features of Asterisk is its ability to ring more than one phone when a number is called.

One application of this feature might be an on-call technician who has a regular office but is often out in the field. When called, if they are in their office they can answer their regular phone but if they are out in the field, they can take the same call on their cell phone.

The context for this might look like this one:

Whichever phone is answered takes the call and the other channel is dropped.

```
exten => 6026,1,Dial(DAHDI/26&IAX2/gwcohn/5205551212,40,rt))
```

```
exten => 6026,n,Hangup()
```

All you have to do is daisy chain ring technologies together using the &

In the above example, it rings a DAHDI channel 26 which is an analog phone, and an IAX2 channel called gwcohn which rings the cell phone.

The timer is set to 40 to allow the person a chance to get to their phone(s) before it times out and hangs up.
